



Mark Statute of SLG Prüf- und Zertifizierungs GmbH

1 General

This mark statute defines the rights of users of SLG marks. The SLG marks are illustrated in paragraphs 5 “Marks for products” and 6 “Marks for quality assurance and quality management systems” of this mark statute.

2 Proprietor of marks

Proprietor of all SLG marks as listed in 5 “Marks for products” and 6 “Marks for quality assurance and quality management systems” is SLG Prüf- und Zertifizierungs GmbH, Burgstädter Straße 20, 09232 Hartmannsdorf, Germany (hereinafter referred to as SLG).

3 User of marks

User of the mark is the certificate holder as stated on the certificate issued by SLG.

4 Entitlement to use a mark

- (1) On receipt of a valid certificate issued by SLG the certificate holder acquires a non-exclusive and non-transferable right of use restricted by time and place for the SLG marks indicated on the certificate. The user of the mark shall only use the graphic templates provided by SLG.
- (2) The entitlement to use the mark is limited to the data stated on the certificate (amongst others, scope, range of services and products, location, validity). The entitlement to use the mark is only granted for the validity period of the certificate.
- (3) SLG marks shall not be used or modified improperly or as not intended without the express written approval by SLG. The use of single details of SLG marks by the mark user shall also require SLG’s prior written consent.
- (4) Violation of SLG’s rights on the SLG marks as well as misuse of certificates or marks may result in denial of both the certificate and the entitlement to use the corresponding SLG marks.
- (5) Should the certificate holder become aware of any misuse of SLG marks and/or the awarded certificate, he shall be obliged to inform SLG without delay.
- (6) The use of GS marks is regulated by the German Product Safety Act superior to this mark statute. The duties of manufacturers and importers are specified in §22. §21 of the German Product Safety Act emphasizes the duty of the GS body to inform other GS bodies, the competent authorities as well as the public about any misuse of GS marks.



5.2 Certification marks not subject to monitoring

Certification marks that are not subject to monitoring are valid as long as the products concerned are identical to the sample tested and as long as the test bases are valid.

5.3 CE marking including the number of the Notified Body

The use of the CE mark is regulated in the European legislation applicable for the product.

The marking including the number must be used if it is provided for in the relevant European legislation, and the relevant requirements are met.


The marking with number must not be used if the corresponding European legislation does not provide for this marking. Use outside the legally stipulated regulation is prohibited.

6 Marks for quality assurance and quality management systems

The conditions for granting and use of the following SLG marks are regulated in the applicable contract documents (among others, "Regulations for Certification of Quality Assurance and Quality Management Systems of SLG Prüf- und Zertifizierungs GmbH").

The use of marks for quality management/ assurance systems within the legally-regulated area concerns the CE marking of products including the number of the Notified Body SLG, see also paragraph 5.3 "CE marking including the number of the Notified Body". The relevant legislation shall apply.

The following marks may be used on papers intended for business correspondence as well as for marketing purposes. They shall not be used in conjunction with the marking of products (for example, as a statement about their quality).
